 - **Tip**: Rental car companies can be found at the airport and in town centers. Book in advance for better deals.
- **Taxis**: Taxis are widely available and can be booked through apps like **TaxiClick**. However, in October, availability may be limited in remote areas.
- Public Transport: Ibiza has a decent bus system, but services may be reduced in October. Bus Ibiza offers routes connecting key towns, but it's not the best for exploring remote calas or staying late.
- **Bike and Scooter Rentals**: Great options for those who prefer exploring outdoors. Many rental companies offer daily and weekly rates for both.

The hotel is just a **15-minute walk from the center of Santa Eulalia**, a charming town with various dining options, shops, and a relaxed atmosphere.

• **Dinner**: For those wanting a meal in town, we recommend **Estel** and **CBBC**. Both places offer a fantastic dining experience.

• **Coffee**: If you're looking for a cozy spot to work or relax, **Meke** has excellent coffee and a great ambiance.

- **Tips**: Best for afternoons and evenings with live DJ sets. Book a sunbed in advance for weekends.

3. Tanit Beach Ibiza

- o **Location**: Playa d'en Bossa
- **Distance from Hotel**: 25 minutes by car (22 km)
- **Description**: Laid-back beach club offering refreshing cocktails, Mediterranean fusion cuisine, and a bohemian vibe. Less crowded in October but still lively.
- **Tips**: Visit around 3:00 PM for a late lunch and cocktail by the sea.

Best Sunset Spots

1. Cala Benirrás

- **Distance from Hotel**: 35 minutes by car (25 km)
- Description: Famous for its sunset drum circles (though more subdued in October). You can still enjoy a magical sunset view over the "Finger of God" rock formation.
- Best Time: Arrive by 5:30 PM to grab a good spot for sunset around 6:30 PM.
- **Restaurant**: **Elements Ibiza** nearby offers Mediterranean dishes with a view.

2. Mirador de Es Vedrà

- **Distance from Hotel**: 45 minutes by car (32 km)
- Description: This viewpoint offers one of the best sunset experiences in Ibiza, with the magical Es Vedrà rock in the background. A more relaxed, natural setting with no facilities, so pack snacks and drinks.
- **Best Time**: Arrive by 6:00 PM to watch the sun dip behind Es Vedrà.

Calas and Beaches to Visit in October

1. Cala Saladeta

- **Distance from Hotel**: 35 minutes by car (27 km)
- **Description**: A small, quiet beach with crystal-clear waters and stunning rock formations. October is the perfect time to visit as it will be less crowded.
